




"How to make a bow" TUTORIAL by FORTINO37



You can see here that both ends are bend 1/4 in and ironed.




You can bend the shorter part of the bow and pass the iron to have a clear view of the middle of the bow to keep symmetry in the following steps.



Pinch with your fingers at the middle and a little bit lower to overlap a small portion of the ribbon



Here is the needle passing thru the pinch.



Here is how it looks with the tight stitches




Then you have to overlap a little portion of the ribbon right above the stitches.



Pass the needle 3 or 4 times and make a knot at the back.



Here is a rear view of the bow



For the knot you will need an other piece of ribbon large enough to involve the bow by the middle and to overlap both ends 1/4 in.




Bend both sides to meet at the center and pass the iron



Put the knot around the bow to see how it fits and to see where to stitch the knot ends.



Then you can make the stitches to complete the knot



Then just pass one side of the bow thru the knot and place it right over the stitches that are in the middle of the bow



And ther is the bow finished, you can fix the knot with few stitches from behind.
